

ADDITION WORD PROBLEMS



1. The children in Hufflepuff have 48 house points and the children in Ravenclaw have 46 house points. How many house points do they have altogether?
2. There are 45 forks in the canteen. This number is increased by 36. How many forks are there now?
3. There were 65 books in the library. Mrs Jones bought 98 more books. How many books are in the library now?
4. There were 47 people at the football match. 78 more people arrived at half time. How many people were at the football match altogether?
5. Mr Brown bought two boxes of pencils at the start of term. There were 64 pencils in one box and 25 boxes in the other box. How many pencils did Mr Brown order altogether?
6. At sports day Gryffindor won 42 house points and Slytherin won 29 house points. How many house points did they win altogether?
7. At the school concert 27 raffle tickets were sold in the first half. Another 44 raffle tickets were sold in the second half. How many raffle tickets were sold altogether?
8. There were 37 pieces of Lego in one box, 33 pieces in a second box and 25 pieces in the third box. How many pieces of Lego were there altogether?
9. Tesco counted the number of customers they had in the shop each day. On Monday they had 28 customers, on Tuesday they had 86 customers and on Wednesday they had 99 customers. How many customers did they have altogether?
10. The golf club had to buy new golf balls. They bought a box of 52 golf balls and a box of 26 golf balls. How many golf balls did they buy altogether?
